Subject: Advisory Committee on Freedom of Movement for Workers
- Appointment of Mr Kai SCHATTENBERG, member for Germany, in
place of Mr John F. SCHILLING, who has resigned

1. The General Secretariat of the Council has been informed of the resignation of Mr John F. SCHILLING as member of the above Committee in the employers' representatives category (for Germany).
2. Under Article 24 of Regulation (EU) No 492/2011 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 5 April 2011 on freedom of movement for workers within the Union, members and alternate members are appointed by the Council.

3. In accordance with the usual procedure, the Government of Germany has nominated the following candidate for the remainder of the current term of office, ending on 24 September 2016:

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN UNION,

Having regard to Regulation (EU) No 492/2011 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 5 April 2011 on freedom of movement for workers within the Union¹, and in particular Articles 23 and 24 thereof.

Whereas:

- (1) In its Decision of 25 September 2014², the Council appointed the members and alternate members of the Advisory Committee on Freedom of Movement for Workers for the period ending on 24 September 2016.
- (2) A seat as member in the employers' representatives category has fallen vacant as a result of the resignation of Mr John F. SCHILLING.
- (3) The Government of Germany has submitted a nomination for the vacant seat,
