Subject:	Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) No/ of 30.10.2013 on the conditions for making a declaration of performance on construction products available on a website
	- Intention not to raise objections to a delegated act

 The <u>Commission</u> has submitted the above delegated act¹ to the Council in accordance with the procedure set out in Article 290 TFEU and Article 60 of Regulation (EU) No 305/2011 laying down harmonised conditions for the marketing of construction products and repealing Council Directive 89/106/EE. The delegated act is based on Article 7 (3) of that Regulation. The Commission having notified the delegated act to the Council on 30 October 2013, the Council had originally until 30 January 2014 to object to it.

- 2. The <u>Working Party on Technical Harmonisation</u> had examined the delegated act by written procedure and also at a meeting on 11 December 2013. It had agreed by simple majority to request an extension of the period for possible objections to **30 April 2014**.
- The <u>Permanent Representatives Committee</u> and the <u>Council</u> confirmed this extension². The <u>European Parliament</u> and the Commission have been informed on this extension of the deadline.
- 4. On 27 January 2014 the <u>Working Party on Technical Harmonisation</u> examined the delegated act for a second time and agreed not to object to the delegated act³.
- 5. It is therefore suggested that the <u>Permanent Representatives Committee</u> recommends that the <u>Council</u> confirms that it has no intention to object the delegated act and that the Commission and the European Parliament are to be informed thereof. This implies, that unless the <u>European Parliament</u> objects to it, the delegated act shall be published and enter into force in accordance with Article 60 of Regulation (EU) No 305/2011.
