Sir,

Pursuant to Articles 9(1) and 41(1) - (2) of Council Decision 2009/426/JHA of 16 December 2008 on the strengthening of Eurojust and amending Council Decision 2002/187/JHA setting up Eurojust with a view to reinforcing the fight against serious crime, I have the honour to inform you about the renewal of Mr László Venczl's appointment as the National Member for Hungary to the European Union's Judicial Cooperation Unit (Eurojust) for another four years.

Mr László Venczl has been on duty as prosecutor since 1987. He has been practicing different senior and managing positions within the Prosecution Service for more than 10 years. Presently he is the Deputy Head of Department for International and European Affairs of the Office of the Prosecutor General. Mr László Venczl was first appointed as National Member to Eurojust in 2012, and he has successfully worked in fulfilling the international cooperation needs of the Hungarian judicial authorities.

Mr László Venczl will continue his renewed position in The Hague as from 1 July 2016.
