- 1. <u>The General Secretariat of the Council</u> has been informed of the resignation of Mr Grzegorz BACZEWSKI as member of the above Committee in the employers' representatives category (for Poland).
- 2. Under Article 24 of Regulation (EU) No 492/2011 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 5 April 2011 on freedom of movement for workers within the Union, members and alternate members are appointed by the Council.

Having regard to Regulation (EU) No 492/2011 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 5 April 2011 on freedom of movement for workers within the Union¹, and in particular Articles 23 and 24 thereof.

Whereas:

- (1) In its Decision of 25 September 2014², the Council appointed the members and alternate members of the Advisory Committee on Freedom of Movement for Workers for the period ending on 24 September 2016.
- (2) A seat as member in the employers' representatives category has fallen vacant as a result of the resignation of Mr Grzegorz BACZEWSKI.
- (3) The Government of Poland has submitted a nomination for the vacant seat,
