Subject: **Anti-dumping**

Proposal for a Council Implementing Regulation of xx 2014 repealing the anti-dumping duty on imports of dicyandiamide originating in the People's Republic of China following an expiry review pursuant to Article 11(2) of Regulation (EC) No 1225/2009

---

1. On 13 January 2014, the Commission transmitted the above proposal circulated as document 5272/14 ANTIDUMPING 2 COMER 9.
2. Delegations were requested to examine the proposal and consequently expressed their positions by 20 January 2014 (doc. 5273/14).
3. On 28 January 2014, the Commission requested to delete a footnote from the Recital 89 of the proposal (page 18), because the Union industry producer claimed confidentiality with regard to the information contained therein. The Commission services consider it prudent to accept this claim.

4. Delegations are therefore invited to agree to delete the above-mentioned footnote.

If no comments have been received by the General Secretariat of the Council (e-mailed to *secretariat.polcom@consilium.europa.eu* or faxed to +32 2 281 73 74) before **Friday, 31 January 2014 (cob, 17h00)**, the footnote will be deleted from the Recital 89 and the proposal will be submitted for approval to the Permanent Representatives Committee (Part 2, meeting on 5 February 2014, as "I" item), with a view to its adoption as "A" item by the Council at its meeting on 11 February 2014. Publication in the Official Journal is scheduled for 13 February 2014.
