Subject: COMMISSION DELEGATED REGULATION (EU) No .../.. of 17.5.2016 amending Delegated Regulation (EU) No 1222/2014 with regard to regulatory technical standards for the specification of the methodology for the identification of global systemically important institutions and for the definition of subcategories of global systemically important institutions
= intention not to raise objections to a delegated act

1. On 17 May 2016, the Commission submitted the above-mentioned delegated act¹ to the Council in accordance with the procedure set out in Article 290 TFEU and with Article 11(2) of Regulation 1093/2010 EU².

2. No objections were raised by delegations during the silence procedure expired on 2 June 2016.
 3. It is therefore suggested that Coreper recommend that the Council confirm that it has no intention to object to the delegated act and that the Commission and the European Parliament are to be informed thereof. This implies that, unless the European Parliament objects to it, the delegated act shall be published and enter into force in accordance with Article 13(2) of Regulation 1093/2010 EU.
