Subject:	<b>Anti-subsidies</b> Proposal for a Council Implementing Regulation imposing a definitive countervailing duty on imports of crystalline silicon photovoltaic modules and key components (i.e. cells) originating in or consigned from the People's Republic of China

Delegations are requested to examine the above Commission proposal, circulated on 6 November 2013 as document 15704/13 ANTIDUMPING 97 COMER 252, on which the Council should act as soon as possible.

Please note, that the legal basis should read:

"Having regard to Council Regulation (EC) No 597/2009 on protection against subsidised imports from countries not members of the European Community<sup>1</sup>, and in particular Article 15 thereof, (...)".

Article 17, which is mentioned in the proposal will be deleted, the Commission confirmed that this mistake was of a clerical nature.
