Subject: Adoption of a Council Decision on the Conclusion, on Behalf of the European Union, of the Protocol to Eliminate Illicit Trade in Tobacco Products to the World Health Organisation's Framework Convention on Tobacco Control, in so far as the Provisions of the Protocol Which Do Not Fall under Title V of Part III of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union are Concerned

1. On 4 May 2015, the Commission submitted to the Council the above proposal, which aims at adopting a Decision on the conclusion of a Protocol to the Framework Convention on Tobacco Control (FCTC) meant to eliminate the illicit trade in tobacco products. The proposal is based on Articles 33, 113, 114, and 207 in conjunction with Art. 218(6)(a) and the second paragraph of Art. 218(8) of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union (TFEU).
  
2. At its meeting on 6 November 2015, the Working Party on Customs Union reached an agreement on an amended version of the text of proposal, as laid down in doc. 12282/2/15 REV 2.

3. On 9 December 2013, the Council adopted its Decision<sup>1</sup> on the signing of the above Protocol.
  4. The Protocol was signed on 20 December 2013.
  5. On 7 June 2016, the Parliament voted its consent to the conclusion of the Agreement.
  6. Under these circumstances, the Permanent Representatives Committee could therefore invite the Council to adopt the Council Decision as set out in 14384/15 UD 222 SAN 387 COPEN 320 DROIPEN 151 and 15044/13 UD 268 SAN 400 COPEN 164 DROIPEN 126 (texts revised by the legal-linguistic experts) as an item without discussion at one of its forthcoming meetings.
