Subject:	The Council of the EU <b>PRADO</b> Glossary, explaining technical terms related to security features, and to security documents in general

In chapter 061, the first paragraph reads as follows:

A **traditional watermark** is a picture, text or character design which is produced by pressure on the substrate during manufacture, leading to a varying thickness of the paper. It is sometimes also called **Fourdrinier watermark**.

In chapter 083 the following new last indent is added: "

Not all of these document categories and document types are described in the **PRADO** database. "

In chapter 187 the second paragraph reads as follows:

"A special metamerism effect is for example **infrared drop-out**: the otherwise visible ink cannot be seen in part of the **infrared range** of the spectrum."

In chapters 103, 126, 156 and 173 the mention "See also: ➡ Infrared light (IR light) " is to be removed.
