**Information-sheet for Member States concerning the  
Agricultural Markets Task Force, Council meeting on 27 June 2016**

In January 2016, a Commission expert group has been set up by the name of "Agricultural Markets Task Force" (TF). It consists of 12 experts external to the EC (Annex A). It is headed by Dutch ex-agricultural minister **Mr Cees Veerman**.

The participation of the European agri-food sector in global markets has created important trading opportunities but also exposed it to greater market instability and increased price volatility.

The task of the TF is to provide the Commission with advice and expertise regarding the **functioning of agricultural markets and the farmers' position in the food supply chain**. It is to make recommendations and propose policy initiatives in this field so as improve future conditions for farmers, taking into account global challenges for sustainable agriculture.

The TF will present its outcomes in a **final report in autumn 2016**.

The themes the TF looks into are market transparency, access for farmers to futures and financial instruments to hedge price risks, options for arranging contractual relations within the chain and legal possibilities for organising farmers' collective actions.

The work of the group is organised around meetings in Brussels on specific sub-themes (Annex B). Four meetings have taken place so far. A fifth and a sixth meeting are scheduled for 28 June and 15 September respectively. The morning sessions of its meetings are normally dedicated to hearing ad hoc specialists concerning a specific theme. The theme is then discussed on the basis of an Issue Paper circulated by the Chair.

The TF also engaged with COMAGRI, with the Civil Dialogue Group and other stakeholders. It will meet the High Level representatives of the Member States to discuss the particular problems in the dairy sector on 16 September.

Relevant documentation concerning the activities of the TF can be found on the website of the TF (search engine entry "Agricultural Markets Task Force").<sup>1</sup> On the website there is an **invitation to stakeholders to send comments** and ideas to the TF.

The TF is distinct from the High Level Forum for a Better Functioning Food Supply Chain in that it focuses on the position of agricultural producers in the supply chain. The TF's mandate is also more limited in time: it has been set up and will finish its work in 2016. The High Level Forum was established in 2011. Its duration has been extended last year and now covers 2015-2019. The High Level Forum comprises Member State national authorities responsible for the food sector at ministerial level and representatives of the private sector.
