- 1. The Commission submitted the above recommendation to the Council on 20 December 2013¹.
- 2. The Working Party on External Fisheries policy examined the recommendation on 23 and 30 January 2014 and reached an agreement on the text on the basis of a draft Council decision including negotiating directives².
- 3. <u>The Danish and Netherlands delegations</u> entered Parliamentary scrutiny reserves. <u>The Danish</u>, Netherlands and Swedish delegations also entered scrutiny reserves.

 - adopts the Decision on opening negotiations and including the negotiating directives as set out in doc. 6051/14 PECHE 48;
 - decides not to publish the Decision in accordance with Article 17(2)(b) of its
 Rules of Procedure;
 - notes that the European Parliament will be informed in accordance with Article
 218(10) TFEU, and therefore a paper copy of the Decision including the
 negotiating directives will be transmitted to the Parliament;
 - enters the Commission statement in the Addendum to this note in the minutes of the Council.
