1. On 20 May 2016, the Commission submitted to the Council a proposal for a Council Decision on the Union position to be adopted in the Joint Committee established by the Framework Agreement on Comprehensive Partnership and Cooperation between the European Community and its Member States, of the one part, and the Republic of Indonesia, of the other part, on adopting the Joint Committee's rules of procedure, and setting up specialised working groups.

2. Following examination of the proposal by the Asia Oceania Working Party on 1 June 2016, all delegations agreed to the draft Council Decision in question.
3. The Permanent Representatives Committee is accordingly invited to recommend that the Council at one of its upcoming meetings:
  - adopts as an 'A' item the Council Decision on the Union position to be adopted in the Joint Committee established by the Framework Agreement on Comprehensive Partnership and Cooperation between the European Community and its Member States, of the one part, and the Republic of Indonesia, of the other part, on adopting the Joint Committee's rules of procedure, and setting up specialised working groups as set out after finalisation by the Legal/Linguistic experts in document 9819/16.
