The mandates of six EU Special Representatives (EUSRs) were renewed in 2015 for 16 months instead of initially foreseen 12 months, i.e. until 28 February 2017. The renewal of other three EUSRs in 2016 has been financed through funds recovered from previous actions (for an amount of EUR 2.9 million). Therefore, the full amount of EUR 25 million in commitment appropriations can be used to reinforce other budget lines in Heading 4.
