### 1. Work programme of the incoming Presidency – Presentation by the Slovak delegation

The incoming Slovak Presidency gave a preview of its work programme and key dates and events. A comprehensive presentation will be given at the WPAQ meeting of 7 July.

### 2. Any other business

#### a) Nuclear items at the 6 June TTE (Energy) Council

The Presidency briefed delegations about the outcomes of the TTE (Energy) Council of 6 June 2016 concerning the two nuclear AOB points on the agenda, security of supply of medical radioisotopes and action 10 of the SET-Plan on nuclear safety. Referring to the AOB point on medical radioisotopes, the Commission noted that the Commissioner's statement was not fully reflected in the outcome of the Council meeting. The Commission will propose a correction.

**b) IAEA ARTEMIS workshop**

Coming back to the question raised by SE at the previous WPAQ meeting, i.e. whether the Commission intended to develop a common position for the IAEA regional workshop, the Commission noted that MS are able to define the scope of ARTEMIS missions and that a common position was therefore not possible. The Commission recalled that a workshop would take place from 4-6 July to develop guidance, and hoped that this would clarify the matter further.

**c) PINC**

The Presidency informed delegations that the summary report on the WPAQ discussion on the Nuclear Illustrative Programme (PINC) would be circulated in the coming weeks (*doc. 9525/16, circulated on 30 June*).
