# Proposal for a

#### **COUNCIL DECISION**

on the conclusion of the Multilateral Agreement between the European Community and its Member States, the Republic of Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, the Republic of Bulgaria, the Republic of Croatia, the European Community, the Republic of Iceland, the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia, the Republic of Iceland, the Republic of Montenegro, the Kingdom of Norway, Serbia and Montenegro, Romania, the Republic of Serbia and the United Nations Interim Administration Mission in Kosovo<sup>1</sup> on the Establishment of a European Common Aviation Area (ECAA)

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN UNION <u>AND THE REPRESENTATIVES</u>

<u>OF THE MEMBER STATES OF THE EUROPEAN UNION MEETING WITHIN THE</u>

<u>COUNCIL</u>,

Having regard to the Treaty **on the Functioning of the European Union** establishing the European Community, and in particular Article **100** (2), 80, paragraph 2, in conjunction with Article 300, paragraph 2, first sentence of the first subparagraph thereof, and Article 300, paragraph 4, Article **218** (6)(a) and **218** (8) thereof,

Having regard to the proposal from the **European** Commission,

Pursuant to UN Security Council Resolution 1244 of 10 June 1999.

Having regard to the opinion consent of the European Parliament<sup>2</sup>,

#### Whereas:

- (1) The Council has authorised the Commission to open negotiations with certain European third countries to establish a European Common Aviation Area (ECAA);
- (2) The Commission has negotiated on behalf of the Community and its Member States a Multilateral Agreement with Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Croatia, Iceland, the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia, Iceland, Montenegro, Norway, Serbia and Montenegro, Romania, Serbia and the United Nations Interim Administration Mission in Kosovo on the establishment of a European Common Aviation Area in accordance with the Council Decision authorising the Commission to open the negotiations.
- (3) This Agreement was signed on behalf of the Union Community on 9 June 2006<sup>3</sup>, subject to its possible conclusion at a later date, in conformity with the decision .../.../EC of the Council on in accordance with Decision 2006/682/EC of the Council and of the Representatives of the Member States of the European Union meeting within the Council.
- (4) This Agreement should be approved.

## Article 1

- 1. The Multilateral Agreement between the Republic of Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, the Republic of Bulgaria, the Republic of Croatia, the European Community, the Republic of Iceland, the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia, **Montenegro**, the Kingdom of Norway, Serbia and Montenegro, Romania, Serbia and the United Nations Interim Administration Mission in Kosovo on the Establishment of a European Common Aviation Area (ECAA), hereinafter 'the Agreement', is **hereby** approved on behalf of the **Union** Community.
- 2. The President of the Council is hereby authorised to designate the person(s) empowered to sign the Agreement on behalf of the Community, subject to its conclusion.
- 3. Pending its entry into force, the Agreement shall be applied in accordance with Article 29(3) thereof. The President of the Council is hereby authorised to make the notification referred to in that provision on behalf of the Union Community and its Member States.
- 4. The text of the Agreement is attached to this Decision.

- 1. The **Union** Community and the Member States shall be represented in the Joint Committee set up under Article 18 of the Agreement. by the Commission assisted by representatives of the Member States.
- 2. The position to be taken by the Union Community and its Member States as regards decisions of the Joint Committee under Article 17 of the Agreement, which simply extend acts of Union legislation by including them into Annex I to the Agreement, subject to any technical adjustments needed, shall be adopted by the Commission.
- 3. For other Joint Committee decisions concerning matters that fall within Union competence, the position of the Union and its Member States shall be adopted by the Council, acting by qualified majority, on a proposal from the Commission.
- 4. For other Joint Committee decisions concerning matters which fall within Member States' competence, the position to be presented shall be adopted by the Council, acting by unanimity, on a proposal from the Commission or from Member States.
- 5. The position of the Union and the Member States in the Joint Committee shall be presented by the Commission, except in areas that fall exclusively within Member States' competence in which case it shall be presented by the Presidency of the Council or, if the Council so decides, by the Commission.
