Subject: COMMISSION DELEGATED REGULATION (EU) .../... of 14.7.2016 amending Regulation (EU) No 167/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council as regards the list of requirements for vehicle EU type-approval, and amending and correcting Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) No 1322/2014, Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2015/96, Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2015/68 and Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2015/208 with regard to vehicle construction and general requirements, to environmental and propulsion unit performance requirements, to vehicle braking requirements and to vehicle functional safety requirements

- *Intention not to raise objections to a delegated act*

1. The Commission has submitted the above delegated act to the Council in accordance with the procedure set out in Article 290(2)(b) TFEU and with regard to Articles 17(5), 18(4), 19(6), 20(8), 27(6), 28(6), 49(3), 53(12), 60(1), 61 and 70 of Regulation (EU) No 167/2013 on the approval and market surveillance of agricultural and forestry vehicles¹. The Commission having adopted the delegated act on 14 July 2016, the Council may object to it until 14 September 2016.

2. The Working Party on Technical Harmonisation (Motor Vehicles) has examined the delegated act by an electronic information procedure initiated on 18 July 2016 and silently agreed that there are no grounds for the Council to object to it.
 3. It is therefore suggested that the Permanent Representatives Committee recommends to the Council to confirm that it has no intention to object to the delegated act and that the Commission and the European Parliament are to be informed thereof. This implies that, unless the European Parliament objects to it, the delegated act shall be published and enter into force on the day following that of its publication in the Official Journal of the European Union in accordance with Article 6 of the Delegated Regulation.
