Subject: Proposal for a Council Decision on the repeal of Council Decision
2007/124/EC, Euratom
- Request by the Council for the consent of the European Parliament

1. On 9 August 2013, the Commission submitted to the Council the above proposal, which aims at repealing Council Decision 2007/124/EC, Euratom establishing for the period 2007 to 2013 the Specific Programme "Prevention, Preparedness and Consequence Management of Terrorism and other Security related risks" as this policy area would receive financial support from the Internal Security Fund under the new multiannual financial framework 2014-2020. The legal basis of the proposal requires the consent of the European Parliament.
2. On 1 October 2013 the proposal was presented by the Commission to the JHA Counsellors and approved in their consequent meeting on 18 October 2013.

3. Under these circumstances, the Council should decide on the transmission of the draft decision to the European Parliament in order to obtain its consent.
 4. The Permanent Representatives Committee is therefore invited to suggest to the Council to decide, in part "A" of the agenda of a forthcoming meeting, to forward the draft decision as contained in document 15187/13 JAI 928 ENFOPOL 328 PROCIV 123 CATS 59 CAFREFIN 267 (text finalised by the legal/linguistic experts) to the European Parliament for its consent.
