Dear Mr Director-General,

I have the honor to notify the General Secretariat of the Council of the European Union on the implementation by Romania of the **Framework Decision 2006/783/JHA of 6th of October 2006** on the application of the principle of mutual recognition to confiscation orders, published in the Official Journal of the European Union no. L 328 of 24th of October 2006.

Having in view that by Law no. 300 from 15 November 2013 for the amendment and supplemental of the Law no. 302/2004 on the international judicial cooperation in criminal matters, published in the Official Gazette of Romania on 11 December 2013 there have been certain amendments to the provisions concerning the transposition of the Framework Decision 2006/783/JHA of 6th of October 2006 on the application of the principle of mutual recognition to confiscation orders, Romania *hereby supplements* its notification as it follows:

In accordance with Article 7(5) Romania declares that its competent authorities will not recognize and execute confiscation orders under circumstances where confiscation of the property was ordered under the extended powers of confiscation referred to in Article 2(d)(iv) if the method of confiscation mentioned in the confiscation order is not permitted in Romania under its domestic law.
