- Approval of the final compromise text

---

1. The European Commission submitted, on 23 April 2013, its amended proposal for a Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council on the European Maritime and Fisheries Fund [repealing Council Regulation (EC) No 1198/2006 and Council Regulation(EC) No 861/2006 and Council Regulation No XXX/2011 on integrated maritime policy<sup>1</sup>.
2. The "Agriculture and Fisheries" Council adopted on 15 July 2013 a general approach on the amended proposal<sup>2</sup>.

3. The European Parliament's adopted on 23 October 2013 a set of amendments, but not the political resolution, on the amended proposal<sup>3</sup>.
  4. On 28 January 2014, a political agreement was reached with the Parliament on the proposal.
  5. Hence, the Presidency requests COREPER to grant it permission to send a letter to the European Parliament setting out the position that should the European Parliament adopt its position at first reading, in accordance with Article 294, paragraph 3, of the Treaty, in the form set out in the compromise package contained in the addendum to this note (subject to revision by the legal linguists of both institutions), the Council would, in accordance with Article 294, paragraph 4, of the Treaty, approve the European Parliament's position and the act shall be adopted in the wording which corresponds to the European Parliament's position.
