Subject: Draft Council Conclusions on the implementation of the general provisions on data protection of Chapter 6 of Council Decision 2008/615/JHA
- Evaluation of Greece with regard to automated data exchange of DNA data

1. Prior to the adoption of a Council Implementing Decision on the launch of automated data exchange after having consulted the European Parliament, the Council adopts Conclusions acknowledging that the conditions for the launch of automated data exchange have been fulfilled.
2. The Working Party on Information Exchange and Data Protection (DAPIX) approved at its meeting on 1 July 2014 the evaluation visit report on DNA data exchange for Greece subject to the submission of an amended declaration on national DNA analysis files (10560/1/14 REV 1 JAI 425 DAPIX 78 CRIMORG 53 ENFOPOL 162 ENFOCUSTOM 76). DAPIX approved as well the overall report (10627/14 JAI 439 DAPIX 84 CRIMORG 54 ENFOPOL 170 ENFOCUSTOM 77) based on the questionnaire, an evaluation visit and a pilot run.
3. The General Secretariat of the Council received the amended declaration on 22 July 2016 (11912/16 DAPIX 137 CRIMORG 96 ENFOPOL 168).

4. At the DAPIX meeting of 13 September 2016, it was acknowledged that each Member State bound by Decision 2008/615/JHA agrees that the conditions are fulfilled for the Council to conclude that for the purposes of automated data exchange with regard to **DNA data, Greece** has fully implemented the general provisions on data protection of Chapter 6 of Decision 2008/615/JHA.
 5. DAPIX agreed on the text of the draft Council Conclusions set out in **11926/16 JAI 718 DAPIX 138 CRIMORG 97 ENFOPOL 269 ENFOCUSTOM 122**.
 6. *Coreper is invited to submit the draft Council Conclusions as set out in the Annex to **12210/16 JAI 758 DAPIX 146 CRIMORG 102 ENFOPOL 283 ENFOCUSTOM 129** to the Council and to suggest that it adopts these draft Conclusions as an "A" item on its agenda.*
