establishing fisheries conservation measures for the protection of the  
marine environment in the Baltic Sea and repealing Regulation (EU)  
2015/1778  
*- Intention not to raise objections to a delegated act*

---

1. On 5 September 2016, the Commission submitted the above mentioned delegated act<sup>1</sup> to the European Parliament and to the Council in accordance with Article 290 of the TFEU and Article 46(5) of Regulation (EU) No 1380/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 11 December 2013 on the Common Fisheries Policy.<sup>2</sup> The Commission having notified the delegated act on 5 September 2016, the Council may object to it until 5 November 2016.
2. The Working Party on Internal Fisheries Policy, through an informal written procedure, examined the delegated act and agreed that there are no grounds for the Council to object to it.
3. It is therefore suggested that Coreper recommend that the Council confirms that it has no intention to object to the delegated act.
