The Presidency intends organising a meeting of the Working Party on Cooperation in Criminal Matters (COPEN) on 16 December 2016. Issues on the provisional agenda include the report of the EU-Japan Day on 14 July, the draft standardised forms regarding Framework Decision 2005/214/JHA on financial penalties (as discussed at the COPEN meeting in April), the state of play and practical issues concerning the implementation of Directive 2014/41/EU on the European Investigation Order, and the follow-up of the recommendations on the EU-US MLA Agreement.
