## **'I/A' ITEM NOTE**

Subject:	Amendments of the European Parliament to the Council's position on the draft budget for 2017

- 1. During its Plenary session of 26 October 2016, the <u>European Parliament</u> intends to adopt amendments to the Council's position on the draft budget for 2017, as recommended by the European Parliament's Committee on Budgets on 28 September 2016. At this occasion, the Presidency of the Council should take note of this fact, and consequently agree that the President of the European Parliament convenes the Conciliation Committee as required (point (c) of Article 314(4) TFEU).
- 2. On 10 October 2016, the <u>Budget Committee</u> of the Council examined those amendments and agreed, by a qualified majority<sup>1</sup>, that it could not approve them all. For the purposes of the continuation of the budgetary procedure for 2017, the <u>Permanent Representatives Committee</u> is therefore invited to suggest the Council to:
  - confirm that it cannot approve all the amendments to the Council's position on the draft budget for 2017 should they be adopted by the European Parliament;
  - approve the annexed draft letter to the European Parliament to that effect.
