Dear Mr Director-General,

I have the honor to notify the General Secretariat of the Council of the European Union on the implementation by Romania of the **Framework Decision no. 2003/577/JHA of the Council of 22nd of July 2003** on the execution in the European Union of freezing orders of property or evidence, published in the Official Journal of the European Union no. L 196 of 2nd of August 2003.

Having in view that by Law no. 300 from 15 November 2013 for the amendment and supplemental of the Law no. 302/2004 on the international judicial cooperation in criminal matters, published in the Official Gazette of Romania on 11 December 2013 there have been certain amendments to the provisions concerning the transposition of the Framework Decision no. 2003/577/JHA of the Council of 22nd of July 2003 on the execution in the European Union of freezing orders of property or evidence, Romania *hereby supplements* its notification as it follows:
