Subject:	Draft amending budget No 6 to the general budget for 2016 accompanying the proposal to mobilise the European Union Solidarity Fund to provide assistance to Germany

1. On 19 October 2016, the <u>Commission</u> submitted to the Council draft amending budget (DAB) No 6 to the general budget for 2016 regarding the mobilisation of the EU Solidarity Fund for a total amount of EUR 31 475 125 in commitment and payment appropriations.

The objective of this proposal is to provide financial assistance to Germany in response to a series of extremely intense, short-lived cases of floods that affected the region of Niederbayern in May and June 2016.

The corresponding appropriations are to be recorded under Article 13 06 01 (EU Solidarity Fund - Assistance to Member States in the event of a major natural disaster with serious repercussions on living conditions, the natural environment or the economy).

- 2. On 24 October and 3 November 2016, the <u>Budget Committee</u> examined the Commission proposal and was able to accept it without any changes.
- 3. At the close of its examination, the <u>Budget Committee</u> agreed to suggest that the Permanent Representatives Committee advise the Council to:
 - adopt, by a qualified majority¹, the Council's position on DAB No 6/2016 as set out in point 2;
 - instruct the Presidency to prepare the budgetary documents to be sent to the
 European Parliament and to approve the draft letter in Annex 2 to that effect;
 - have the Council's position published in the Official Journal of the European Union as set out in Annex 1.

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN UNION,

Having regard to the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union, and in particular Article 314 thereof, in conjunction with the Treaty establishing the European Atomic Energy Community, and in particular Article 106a thereof,

Having regard to Regulation (EU, Euratom) No 966/2012 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 25 October 2012 on the financial rules applicable to the general budget of the Union and repealing Council Regulation (EC, Euratom) No 1605/2002¹ and in particular Article 41 thereof,

Whereas:

- the Union's budget for the financial year 2016 was definitively adopted on
 November 2015²,
- on 19 October 2016, the Commission submitted a proposal containing draft amending budget
 No 6 to the general budget for the financial year 2016,
- given the fact that draft amending budget No 6 to the general budget for 2016 needs to be adopted without delay, it is justified to shorten, in accordance with Article 3(3) of the Council's Rules of Procedure, the eight-week period for the information of national Parliaments, as well as the ten-day period foreseen for placing the item on the Council's provisional agenda laid down in Article 4 of Protocol No 1,
