Subject: COUNCIL DECISION appointing a member of the Advisory Committee on Freedom of Movement for Workers for Belgium

---

1. The Council appointed the members and alternate members of the Advisory Committee on Freedom of Movement for Workers, by its Decision of 20 September 2016<sup>1</sup>. However, it remained to appoint certain members and alternate members at a later stage.
2. Having regard to Regulation (EU) No 492/2011 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 5 April 2011 on freedom of movement for workers within the Union<sup>2</sup>, and in particular Articles 23 and 24 thereof, members and alternate members are appointed by the Council for a period of two years.
3. One nomination of a member for Belgium of the renewed Advisory Committee has been received by the Council Secretariat, as set out in the draft Council Decision in doc. 14193/16<sup>3</sup>.
