Subject:	COMMISSION DELEGATED REGULATION (EU) .../... of 22.9.2016 on the verification activities and accreditation of verifiers pursuant to Regulation (EU) 2015/757 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the monitoring, reporting and verification of carbon dioxide emissions from maritime transport (Text with EEA relevance) - Intention not to raise objections to the delegated act

1. On 22 September 2016, the Commission submitted the above delegated Regulation to the Council in accordance with the procedure set out in Article 290 TFEU and with Articles 15(5), 16(3) and 23 of Regulation Regulation (EU) 2015/757 ¹.
2. The deadline for raising objections to the delegated act expires on 21 November 2016.
3. On 18 October 2016, the General Secretariat of the Council informed the delegations about this delegated act² and requested their reactions, if any, in writing by 8 November 2016.

4. Following the written consultation, delegations did not provide any indication that there is any reason to raise objections to the delegated act.
 5. The Permanent Representatives Committee is therefore invited to recommend to the Council to confirm it has no intention to object to the delegated act and that the Commission and the European Parliament be informed thereof.
 6. This implies that, unless the European Parliament objects, the delegated act shall enter into force in accordance with Article 23(5) of Regulation (EU) 2015/757.
