While no resettlement took place under the Conclusions of 20 July 2015 yet, 52 Syrians have been resettled under Luxembourg's national programme.
 Portugal resettled 39 refugees from Egypt in 2015 under the national programme, outside of the 20 July 2015 scheme.
 Sweden resettled 1,900 people in 2015 under its national programme, outside of the 20 July 2015 scheme.
 By June 2016, a total of 3,439 people were resettled to the UK under the existing UK national resettlement schemes.
