Delegations will find attached the notification made by Hungary in relation to Framework Decision 2008/947/JHA on the application of the principle of mutual recognition to judgements and probation decisions with a view to the supervision of probation measures and alternative sanctions.

This notification is also included in doc. 14288/13, comprising several notifications by Hungary, but is distributed in this individual format at the request and for the convenience of delegations.

Notification made by Hungary

Council Framework Decision 2008/947/JHA on the application of the principle of mutual recognition to judgments and probation decisions with a view to the supervision of probation measures and alternative sanctions

(i) Hungary wishes to make the following declaration pursuant to **Article 5(4)** of the Framework Decision:

"Pursuant to Article 5(4) of the Council Framework Decision on the application of the principle of mutual recognition to judgments and probation decisions with a view to the supervision of probation measures and alternative sanctions, Hungary declares that it consents to the forwarding of a judgment and, where applicable, a probation decision provided that the sentenced person is not lawfully and ordinarily resident in Hungary, if the sentenced person requests execution of the judgment or the probation decision by the Hungarian authorities and provides proof of close family, cultural or economic connections with Hungary."

(ii) Hungary wishes to make the following declaration pursuant to **Article 10(4)** of the Framework Decision:

"Pursuant to Article 10(4) of the Council Framework Decision on the application of the principle of mutual recognition to judgments and probation decisions with a view to the supervision of probation measures and alternative sanctions, Hungary declares that it will not apply Article 10(1) of that Framework Decision to the offences referred to therein."
