Subject: Implementation of the counter-terrorism agenda set by the European Council

On page 8 of the document ST 14260/16 INIT, the third paragraph should read as follows:

Implementation of **security aspects in the hotspots** has improved. However, implementation of identification and security checks procedures of migrants in Italy are the same both if they are channelled to the hotspots and if they are hosted in places (port/sea places) where there are no hotspots. Italy has halved the times to process asylum applications. Up to 7 November 2016, 163.721 migrants landed in Italy in 2016, out of which 147.667 were photo-fingerprinted⁴. For second line security checks, deployment of Europol guest officers in Italy should happen as soon as possible. In September 2016, Italy agreed that Europol will be associated on the spot for possible secondary security checks including for relocation purposes. The implementation planning concerning the requested involvement of Europol in security measures for relocation is ongoing.
