Subject: COMMISSION DELEGATED REGULATION (EU) .../... of 31.10.2016 amending Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2015/2195 on supplementing Regulation (EU) No 1304/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the European Social Fund, regarding the definition of standard scales of unit costs and lump sums for reimbursement of expenditure by the Commission to Member States

- Intention not to raise objections to a delegated act

---

1. The Commission submitted the delegated act in subject<sup>1</sup> to the Council in accordance with Article 290 TFEU and Article 14(1) of Regulation (EU) No 1304/2013<sup>2</sup>. The Commission having notified the delegated act on 31 October 2016, the Council may object to it until 31 December 2016.

2. The Working Party on Structural Measures examined the delegated act in question on 14 November 2016 and agreed that there are no grounds for the Council to object to the delegated act.
  3. It is therefore suggested that Coreper recommend that the Council confirm that it has no intention to object to the delegated act and that the Commission and the European Parliament are to be informed thereof. This implies that, unless the European Parliament objects to it, the delegated act shall be published and enter into force in accordance with Article 24 of Regulation (EU) No 1304/2013<sup>3</sup>.
