Subject:	Recommendation for a Council Decision to authorise the Commission to open negotiations on behalf of the European Union for the renewal of the protocol to the Fisheries Partnership Agreement with Mauritania
	- Adoption of Council Decision

- 1. <u>The Commission</u> submitted the above recommendation to the Council on 20 December  $2013^{1}$ .
- The Working Party on External Fisheries policy examined the recommendation on 23 and 30 January 2014 and reached an agreement on the text on the basis of a draft Council decision including negotiating directives<sup>2</sup>.
- <u>The Danish and Netherlands delegations</u> entered Parliamentary scrutiny reserves. <u>The Danish</u>, <u>Netherlands and Swedish delegations</u> also entered scrutiny reserves. These reserves have subsequently been lifted.

  - adopts the Decision on opening negotiations and including the negotiating directives as set out in doc. 6051/14 PECHE 48;
  - decides not to publish the Decision in accordance with Article 17(2)(b) of its Rules of Procedure;
  - notes that the European Parliament will be informed in accordance with Article 218(10) TFEU, and therefore a paper copy of the Decision, including the negotiating directives, will be transmitted to the Parliament;
  - enters the statements in the Addendum to this note in the minutes of the Council.
