Subject:	COMMISSION REGULATION (EU) .../... of XXX amending Annexes II, III and V to Regulation (EC) No 396/2005 of the European Parliament and of the Council as regards maximum residue levels for bifenthrin, carbetamide, cinidon-ethyl, fenpropimorph and triflusaluron in or on certain products - <i>Decision not to oppose the adoption (regulatory procedure with scrutiny)</i>

1. On 8 November 2016, the Commission submitted for scrutiny by the European Parliament and the Council a draft COMMISSION REGULATION (EU) .../... of XXX amending Annexes II, III and V to Regulation (EC) No 396/2005 of the European Parliament and of the Council as regards maximum residue levels for bifenthrin, carbetamide, cinidon-ethyl, fenpropimorph and triflusaluron in or on certain products¹.
2. The Working Party of Agricultural Counsellors/Attachés considered through an informal written procedure that there are no grounds for the Council to oppose the adoption of the draft Commission Regulation.
