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Subject: COMMISSION REGULATION (EU) No .../.. of XXX amending Regulation (EC) No 401/2006 as regards methods of sampling of large lots, spices and food supplements, performance criteria for T-2, HT-2 toxin and citrinin and screening methods of analysis

- Decision not to oppose the adoption (regulatory procedure with scrutiny)

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1. On 3 February 2014, following the positive opinion of the Commission's Standing Committee on the Food Chain and Animal Health (on 29 November 2013) the Commission submitted for scrutiny by the Council and the European Parliament a draft Commission Regulation amending Regulation (EC) No 401/2006 as regards methods of sampling of large lots, spices and food supplements, performance criteria for T-2, HT-2 toxin and citrinin and screening methods of analysis.
2. The Working Group of Agricultural Counsellors/Attachés considered through an informal written procedure that there are no grounds for the Council to oppose the adoption of the draft Commission Regulation.

3. The Permanent Representatives Committee is therefore invited:

- to confirm the agreement reached by the Working Group, and
  - to ask the Council to confirm, as an "A" item on its agenda, that it is not opposed to the draft measure proposed by the Commission.
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
