Subject:	Draft COUNCIL IMPLEMENTING DECISION approving the conclusion by the European Police Office (Europol) of the Agreement on Operational and Strategic Cooperation between Georgia and Europol

1. Article 23(2) of Council Decision 2009/371/JHA of 6 April 2009 establishing the European Police Office (Europol)¹ provides that Europol's cooperation agreements "*may be concluded only after the approval by the Council, which shall previously have consulted the Management Board and, as far as it concerns the exchange of personal data, obtained the opinion of the Joint Supervisory Body via the Management Board*".

Article 6, paragraphs (3) and (4) of Council Decision 2009/934/JHA of 30 November 2009 adopting the implementing rules governing Europol's relations with partners, including the exchange of personal data and classified information² further provide that:

"(3) After finalising the negotiations to an agreement, the Director shall submit the draft agreement to the Management Board. In the case of the conclusion of an operational agreement, the Management Board shall obtain the opinion of the Joint Supervisory Body. The Management Board shall endorse the draft agreement before submitting it to the Council for approval.

In case of endorsement of an operational agreement, that draft agreement and the opinion of the Joint Supervisory Body shall be submitted to the Council.

(4) In accordance with Article 23(2) of the Europol Decision, such agreements shall only be concluded after the approval by the Council, which shall previously have consulted the Management Board and, as far as such agreements concern the exchange of personal data, obtained the opinion of the Joint Supervisory Body via the Management Board."

2. By letter dated 12 May 2016, the Chairperson of the Europol Management Board transmitted, in accordance with Article 23(2) of the Europol Council Decision, the draft Agreement on Operational and Strategic Cooperation between Georgia and Europol, as endorsed by the Management Board at its meeting on 11-12 May 2016, to the Council for approval. The opinion of the Joint Supervisory Body (JSB) was also transmitted (8956/16).
3. On 27 May 2016 the aforementioned draft Agreement on Operational and Strategic Cooperation between Georgia and Europol (8956/16) as well as the draft Council Implementing Decision approving the conclusion of this Agreement (8957/16) were presented to the Law Enforcement Working Party (LEWP).
4. Following the approval by the LEWP, the text of the draft Council Implementing Decision approving the conclusion by the European Police Office (Europol) of the Agreement on Operational and Strategic Cooperation between Georgia and Europol has undergone the lawyer-linguist revision. The revised version is set out in 10343/1/16 REV 1.

5. As indicated above, Article 23(2) of Decision 2009/371/JHA and Article 6(4) of Council Decision 2009/934/JHA provide that prior to the approval of the Europol's cooperation agreements the Council "*shall previously have consulted the Management Board*". Following the request by the Permanent Representatives Committee (10923/16), the Management Board issued its positive opinion on 29 July 2016.
6. In line with the judgment of the Court of Justice of the European Union of 16 April 2015 in Case C-540/13, where it ruled that the Council should have consulted the European Parliament before adopting Council Decision 2013/392/EU fixing the date of effect of the VIS Decision, as stipulated by Article 39(1) of the former Treaty on European Union¹ even in cases where the relevant provision of the basic act - like Article 23(2) of Council Decision 2009/371/JHA - does not explicitly provide so², the conclusion of Europol's cooperation agreements with third countries should as from now on be approved by adopting Council Implementing Decisions, regarding which the European Parliament should be consulted on the basis of Article 39(1) of the former Treaty on European Union.
7. The European Parliament delivered its positive opinion on 14 December 2016.
8. *On this basis, the Permanent Representatives Committee is invited to submit the draft Council Implementing Decision approving the conclusion by the European Police Office (Europol) of the Agreement on Operational and Strategic Cooperation between Georgia and Europol, as set out in 10343/1/16 REV 1, to the Council, and to suggest that it adopts this Council Implementing Decision.*
