Subject: COMMISSION DELEGATED REGULATION (EU) .../... of 30.11.2016 amending Delegated Regulations (EU) No 1059/2010, (EU) No 1060/2010, (EU) No 1061/2010, (EU) No 1062/2010, (EU) No 626/2011, (EU) No 392/2012, (EU) No 874/2012, (EU) No 665/2013, (EU) No 811/2013, (EU) No 812/2013, (EU) No 65/2014, (EU) No 1254/2014, (EU) 2015/1094, (EU) 2015/1186 and (EU) 2015/1187 with regard to the use of tolerances in verification procedures  
- Intention not to raise objections to a Delegated Act

1. The Commission has submitted the above delegated act<sup>1</sup> to the Council in accordance with the procedure set out in Article 290 TFEU and with Article 10 of Directive 2010/30/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council on the indication by labelling and standard product information of the consumption of energy and other resources by energy-related products<sup>2</sup>. The Commission having notified the delegated act with regard to the use of tolerances in verification procedures on 30 November 2016, the Council may object to it until 30 January 2017.

2. Delegations were asked to submit any comments on this file by 9 January 2017. On expiry of the deadline, delegations have not provided any indication of grounds for the Council to object to the delegated act.
3. It is therefore suggested that Coreper recommend that the Council confirm that it has no intention to object to the delegated act and that the Commission and the European Parliament are to be informed thereof. This implies that, unless the European Parliament objects to it, the delegated act shall be published and enter into force in accordance with Article 13 of Directive 2010/30/EU.
