Subject:	Recommendation for a COUNCIL DECISION to authorise the Commission to open negotiations on behalf of the European Union for the conclusion of a Sustainable Fisheries Partnership Agreement and protocol with the Republic of Ghana
	- Adoption of the Council Decision

- 1. <u>The European Commission</u> submitted the above recommendation to the Council on 5 January 2017.¹
- 2. <u>The Working Party on Internal and External Fisheries Policy</u> examined the recommendation during its meeting on 19 January 2017 and reached an agreement on the text², while adding a substantive legal base (Art 43 TFEU). <u>NL</u> entered a Parliamentary scrutiny reservation.
- 3. Consequently, COREPER is invited to confirm the agreement reached on the level of the Working Party and suggest that the Council, at a forthcoming session:
 - adopts the Decision on opening negotiations and adopts the negotiating directives as set out in doc. 5526/17 PECHE 27;

The ex-ante evaluation of a Sustainable Fisheries Partnership Agreement and Protocol between the European Union and the Republic of Ghana was received on 19 September 2016 (cf. doc. 12250/16 PECHE 323).
