- Information from the Czech delegation

The Czech Republic would like to inform the ministers that on 22 – 23 May 2017, the 12<sup>th</sup> Plenary Meeting of the European Nuclear Energy Forum (ENEF) will take place in Prague, Czech Republic.

The ENEF was established in November 2007, following the March 2007 European Council, as an advisory body to the European Commission. ENEF provides input to European policy-makers on security of energy supply, incentives for investment, R&D, knowledge management, safety and waste management and many other topics.

This year's ENEF Plenary Meeting will commemorate the 60<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the signing of the Treaty establishing the European Atomic Energy Community (Euratom Treaty).

The 2017 ENEF Plenary Meeting will provide the possibility to discuss current energy topics on the EU agenda. It will be opened by the Czech and Slovak Prime Ministers, Bohuslav Sobotka and Robert Fico, respectively, and a high level representative from the Commission.

Further, the ENEF Plenary Meeting will welcome relevant stakeholders including national regulators, international organisations, research agencies, academia, industry, trade unions and NGOs.

We look forward to welcoming you to the ENEF Plenary Meeting in Prague. The official invitations will follow in due time.
