## **INFORMATION NOTE**

	- Case T-95/14 (Iranian Offshore Engineering & Construction Co against the
	Council)

- By application of 14 February 2014, which was notified on 17 February 2014 to the General Secretariat of the Council by the General Court of the European Union, Iranian Offshore Engineering & Construction Co (IOEC) has brought an action before the General Court pursuant to Articles 263 and 275 TFEU for the annulment, so far as the applicant is concerned, of:
  - a) Council Decision 2013/661/PESC of 15 November 2013 amending Decision 2010/413/PESC concerning restrictive measures against Iran; and
  - b) Council Implementing Regulation (EU) No 1154/2013 of 15 November 2013 implementing Regulation (EU) No 267/2012 concerning restrictive measures against Iran.

- 2. The Applicant raises the following pleas in law:
  - Manifest error in the assessment of the facts on which the contested provisions are based;
  - Breach of the obligation to state reasons;
  - Infringement of the right to effective judicial protection;
  - Misuse of powers;
  - Misinterpretation of the applicable law;
  - Infringement of the right to property; and
  - Breach of the principle of equal treatment.
- In accordance with Article 46(1) of the General Court's Rules of Procedure, the Council has to lodge a statement of defence within two months of the date on which the application was notified to it.
- 4. The Director-General of the Legal Service of the Council has appointed Mr Álvaro DE ELERA-SAN MIGUEL HURTADO and Mr Vincent PIESSEVAUX, legal advisors in the said service, as the Council's agents in this case.
