Subject:	COMMISSION DELEGATED REGULATION (EU) .../... of 16.12.2016 correcting the Bulgarian, Croatian, Czech, Estonian, French, Greek, Lithuanian, Maltese, Romanian, Slovak and Swedish language versions of Delegated Regulation (EU) 2015/35 supplementing Directive 2009/138/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council on the taking-up and pursuit of the business of Insurance and Reinsurance (Solvency II) - intention not to raise objections to a delegated act

1. The Commission submitted the above delegated act¹ to the Council on 16 December 2016 in accordance with the procedure set out in Article 290 TFEU and Article 301a of Directive 2009/138/EC²,
2. In accordance with Article 301a(5) of Directive 2009/138/EC, the Council may object to this delegated act within a period of three months, i.e. until 16 March 2017.
3. No objections were raised by delegations during the silence procedure which expired on 15 February 2017.

It is therefore suggested that Coreper recommend that the Council confirm that it has no intention to object to the delegated act and that the Commission and the European Parliament are to be informed thereof. This implies that, unless the European Parliament objects to it, the delegated act shall be published and enter into force in accordance with Article 301a(5) of Directive 2009/138/EC.
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
