- <u>The European Commission</u> submitted on 23 March 2016 the above proposal for a Council Decision on the conclusion of a Sustainable Fisheries Partnership Agreement between the European Union and the Government of the Cook Islands and the implementation Protocol thereto.
- 2. <u>The Council</u> decided, by written procedure, on 29 April 2016¹ to sign and provisionally apply the Agreement and the Protocol as well as to request the consent of the European Parliament to conclude them following the signing by the Parties².

- 3. The European Union and the Cook Islands signed, on 3 May 2016, in Brussels, and respectively on 14 October 2016, in Avarua, the Agreement and Implementation Protocol thereto. The Agreement accordingly applies provisionally from 14 October 2016, pursuant to Article 16 thereof. The Protocol applies for a duration of four years from the date of its provisional application.
- 4. <u>The European Parliament</u> gave its consent on 14 February 2017.
- <u>COREPER</u> is invited to suggest that the Council, at one of its forth-coming sessions, adopts the Decision to conclude the Agreement and the Protocol as set out in doc. 7592/16 PECHE 119 (as finalised by the legal-linguistic experts), and enters the Commission statement in the addendum to this note in the minutes of the Council.
