Subject: Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) .../... of 3.2.2017 amending  
Delegated Regulation (EU) No 1062/2014 of 4 August 2014 on the work  
programme for the systematic examination of all existing active substances  
contained in biocidal products referred to in Regulation (EU) No 528/2012  
of the European Parliament and of the Council concerning the making  
available on the market and use of biocidal products  
- Intention not to raise objection to a delegated act

---

1. The Commission has submitted the above delegated act<sup>1</sup> to the Council in accordance with the procedure set out in Article 290 TFEU and in particular Article 89(1) of Regulation (EU) No 528/2012 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 22 May 2012 concerning the making available on the market and use of biocidal products<sup>2</sup>. The Commission having notified the delegated act on 3 February 2017, the Council may object to it until 3 April 2017.

2. The Working Party on Environment has examined the delegated act through an informal written procedure and agreed that there are no grounds for the Council to object it.
  
3. It is therefore suggested that Coreper recommends that the Council confirms that it has no intention to object to the delegated act and that the Commission and the European Parliament are to be informed thereof. This implies that, unless the European Parliament objects to it, the delegated act shall be published and enter into force on the twentieth day following its publication in the Official Journal of the European Union in accordance with Article 2 of the Delegated Regulation.
