# MANDATE OF THE SFIC WORKING GROUP SET UP TO MAKE A TOOLBOX FOR INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION

- The Working Group on a Toolbox for international cooperation has the <u>objective</u> to develop a
  practical overview for the Member States, Associated Countries and the Commission in their
  implementation of international STI agreements and STI cooperation activities at bilateral and
  multilateral level.
- 2. The Working Group will focus in particular on the following activities:
  - a) Identify different sets of users for the toolbox (ministries and funding organisations most relevant);
  - b) Gather information from MS/AC/EC, which can provide relevant input to the project;
  - Make an overall assessment, based on relevant existing studies together with input from MS/AC/EC;
  - d) Provide an overview of relevant instruments for international cooperation based on points b) and c);
  - e) Cooperate and coordinate with the SFIC country-specific working groups;
  - f) Collect relevant MS/AC experiences of different instruments as well as examples of good practice;
  - g) Consider possible synergies/links with the new Commission's anticipated Service Facility in support of the strategic development of international cooperation in research and innovation;
  - h) Propose SFIC recommendations based on the mapping and the assessment.

- 3. The Working Group shall contribute to and take account of the EU Multi-Annual Roadmaps, planned policy dialogues and activities in Horizon 2020, as appropriate.
- 4. The Working Group was set up for a period of 18 months, commencing on 29 September 2015. SFIC decided at its plenary meeting on 8 March 2017 to extend the Working Group's mandate by 12 months, commencing on 29 March 2017. This period can be extended after assessment and approval by the SFIC Plenary.
- 5. The SFIC Rules of Procedure (ERAC-SFIC 1355/16) are applicable to this Working Group.
