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Subject: COMMISSION REGULATION (EU) .../... of XXX amending Regulation (EC) No 1881/2006 as regards maximum level of hydrocyanic acid in unprocessed whole, ground, milled, cracked, chopped apricot kernels placed on the market for the final consumer
- *Decision not to oppose adoption*

1. On 3 March 2017, the Commission submitted for scrutiny by the European Parliament and the Council the above draft Regulation, on the basis of Article 2(3) of Council Regulation (EEC) No 315/93¹.
