1. The General Secretariat of the Council has been informed by the United Kingdom Government of its decision to nominate Ms Ann MILLER as its member in the category of Government representatives on the CEDEFOP Governing Board, replacing Mr Ian PEGG.
2. Under Article 4 of Regulation (EEC) No 337/75, as amended by Regulation (EC) No 2051/2004, the members of the Governing Board, except for the Commission's representatives, are appointed by the Council for a period of three years.
3. The Permanent Representatives Committee could therefore suggest that the Council:
 - adopt the Decision annexed hereto as an "A" item on its agenda, and
 - request that it be published in the Official Journal of the European Union for information.

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN UNION,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 337/75 of 10 February 1975 establishing the European Centre for the Development of Vocational Training, and in particular Article 4 thereof ¹,

Having regard to the nomination submitted by the United Kingdom government,

Whereas:

- (1) By its Decisions of 14 July 2015² and of 14 September 2015³, the Council appointed the members of the Governing Board of the European Centre for the Development of Vocational Training for the period from 18 September 2015 to 17 September 2018.
- (2) A member's seat is available for the United Kingdom on the Governing Board of the Centre in the category of Government representatives as a result of the resignation of Mr Ian PEGG.
- (3) The members of the Governing Board of the aforementioned Centre should be appointed for the remainder of the current term of office, which expires on 17 September 2018.
