Subject:	COMMISSION REGULATION (EU) .../... of XXX refusing to authorise a health claim made on foods, other than those referring to the reduction of disease risk and to children's development and health - <i>Decision not to oppose adoption</i>

1. On 24 March 2017, the Commission submitted the above draft Regulation for scrutiny by the European Parliament and by the Council, on the basis of Article 18(5) of Regulation (EC) No 1924/2006 of the European Parliament and of the Council<sup>1</sup>.
2. The Working Party on Foodstuffs considered through an informal written procedure<sup>2</sup>, that there are no grounds for the Council to oppose the adoption of the draft Commission Regulation.
3. The Permanent Representatives Committee is therefore invited to:
  - confirm the agreement reached by the Working Party, and
  - recommend to the Council to confirm, as an "A" item on its agenda, that there are no grounds for opposing the draft measures.
