Subject: Draft Council Regulation amending Council Regulation (EU) No 479/2013 of 13 May 2013 on the waiver from the requirement to submit entry and exit summary declarations for Union goods that are moved across the Neum corridor  
- Adoption

1. On 23 February 2017, the Commission submitted to the Council the above proposal, based on Article 3(4) of the Accession Treaty of Croatia and Article 43 on the Act concerning the Conditions of Accession of Croatia, and aiming at increasing to EUR 15 000 the threshold applicable to the waiver as laid down in Article 3 of Council Regulation (EU) No 479/2013 of 13 May 2013.
2. On 1 March 2017, the Working Party on Customs Union reached an agreement on an amended version of the draft Regulation, as laid down in doc. ST 7200/17.

3. Against this background, the Permanent Representatives Committee could:

- confirm the agreement reached within the Working Party and
  - invite the Council to adopt the draft Regulation as set out in doc. ST 7155/17 UD 72 COWEB 42 (text revised by legal/linguistic experts) as an item without discussion at one of its forthcoming meetings.
