Subject:	Draft Council Conclusions on the implementation of the general provisions on data protection of Chapter 6 of Council Decision 2008/615/JHA - Evaluation of the Czech Republic with regard to automated exchange of vehicle registration data (VRD) = Adoption

1. Prior to the adoption of a Council Implementing Decision on the launch of automated data exchange after having consulted the European Parliament, the Council adopts Conclusions acknowledging that the conditions for the launch of automated data exchange have been fulfilled.
2. The Working Party on Information Exchange and Data Protection (DAPIX) approved at its meeting on 4 April 2017 the evaluation visit report on **vehicle registration data** exchange for the **Czech Republic** (6899/17 DAPIX 69 CRIMORG 47 ENFOPOL 99 ENFOCUSTOM 57 JAI 185) as well as the overall report (7242/17 DAPIX 87 CRIMORG 57 ENFOPOL 118 ENFOCUSTOM 67 JAI 230) based on the questionnaire, an evaluation visit and a pilot run.

3. At the DAPIX meeting of 4 April 2017, it was acknowledged that each Member State bound by Decision 2008/615/JHA agrees that the conditions are fulfilled for the Council to conclude that for the purposes of automated data exchange with regard to **vehicle registration data**, the **Czech Republic** has fully implemented the general provisions on data protection of Chapter 6 of Decision 2008/615/JHA.
 4. DAPIX agreed on the text of the draft Council Conclusions set out in 7244/17 DAPIX 88 CRIMORG 58 ENFOPOL 119 ENFOCUSTOM 68 JAI 231.
 5. *Coreper is invited to submit the draft Council Conclusions as set out in the Annex to 8195/17 DAPIX 137 CRIMORG 81 ENFOPOL 178 ENFOCUSTOM 101 JAI 336 to the Council and to suggest that it adopts these draft Conclusions as an "A" item on its agenda.*
