Subject:	Commission delegated Regulation (EU) No .../.. of 20.3.2017 on the conditions for classification, without testing, of glued laminated timber products covered by the harmonised standard EN 14080 and structural finger jointed solid timber products covered by the harmonised standard EN 15497 with regard to their reaction to fire and amending Decision 2005/610/EC - Intention not to raise objections to a delegated act

1. The Commission has submitted the above delegated act¹ to the Council in accordance with the procedure set out in Article 290 TFEU and Article 60 (g) of Regulation (EU) No 305/2011² laying down harmonised conditions for the marketing of construction products and repealing Council Directive 89/106/EEC. The delegated act is based on Article 27 (5) of that Regulation. The Commission having notified the delegated act to the Council on 20 March 2017, the Council has until 20 June 2017 to object to it.

2. The Working Party on Technical Harmonisation has examined the delegated act by written procedure until 20 April 2017 and has concluded that there are no grounds for the Council to object to it.
 3. It is therefore suggested that the Permanent Representatives Committee recommend that the Council confirm that it has no intention to object the delegated act and that the Commission and the European Parliament are to be informed thereof. This implies, that unless the European Parliament objects to it, the delegated act shall be published and enter into force in accordance with Article 60 of Regulation (EU) No 305/2011.
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
