Subject: COMMISSION DELEGATED REGULATION (EU) .../... of 18.4.2017 amending Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2015/98 on the implementation of the Union's international obligations, as referred to in Article 15(2) of Regulation (EU) No 1380/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council, under the International Convention for the Conservation of the Atlantic Tunas and the Convention on Future Multilateral Cooperation in the Northwest Atlantic Fisheries  
*- Intention not to raise objections to a delegated act*

---

1. On 18 April 2017, the Commission submitted the above mentioned delegated act<sup>1</sup> to the European Parliament and to the Council in accordance with Article 290 of the TFEU and Article 46(5) of Regulation (EU) No 1380/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 11 December 2013 on the Common Fisheries Policy.<sup>2</sup>
2. The Working Party on Internal Fisheries Policy, through an informal written procedure, examined the delegated act and agreed that there are no grounds for the Council to object to it.
3. It is therefore suggested that Coreper recommend that the Council confirms that it has no intention to object to the delegated act.
